# EFNI 2018 executive summary





SOPOT 26-28 SEPTEMBER 2018

After years of economic growth, the world is to face a slowdown. The European economy is getting ready for tougher times and faces a strategic question: How to find its place in the new global economic order? The relative economic stability and peace in Europe is not sufficient to give the Union a safe position in the global mess. The unpredictability of the global economic and political situation is made even worse by the specific manner in which Donald Trump's administration handles its foreign policy. Brexit will leave its mark on global trade as well, but it will also cause changes to the EU budget. The European economy is also facing a difficult dilemma of how to reconcile production efficiency and cost objectives with the climatic goals. New challenges come to surface all the time. Today, we speak about industry 4.0, but industry 5.0 is ahead, with significantly different business models and thinking about the future. Al is an immense, but to large extend unpredictable. It requires a different education system, a different labour market and a transition to a value-adding sharing economy.

In this context, participants of the Forum in Sopot discussed the future of Europe and Poland in Europe.
