- **5. Title, number of pages and language(s) of the notified document:** Removal of Compliance Deadline for Closed-Circuit Escape Respirators (5 page(s), in English)
- 6. **Description of content:** With this deregulatory action, the Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) proposes to revise regulatory language which establishes a deadline by which respirator manufacturers must discontinue the manufacturing, labeling, and sale of certain self- contained self-rescuer models. The National Institute for Occupational Safety and Health (NIOSH) within the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, HHS, has determined that discontinuing the manufacturing, labeling, and sale of certain self-contained self-rescuer models is likely to result in a shortage of personwearable large capacity escape respirators for underground coal miners who rely on these devices.
